 the first part & the Right Reverend John H. Bostwick D.D. Bishop of  
 of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the Diocese of Georgia & his successors  
 one in Office of the second part  
 Witnesseth that the said Thomas P. Morris for & in consideration of the sum  
 of one hundred dollars in hand paid by the part of the second part the receipt  
 whereof is hereby acknowledged, <sup>and</sup> by these presents give grant bargain sell & convey  
 unto the Right Reverend John H. Bostwick & his successors in Office in trust  
 for the use of a parish of the Protestant Episcopal Church to be hereafter formed  
 in the town of Valdosta Landon County, Georgia a certain lot of land situate  
 lying & being in the town of Valdosta County & State aforesaid known  
 & distinguished in the plan of said town as lot number eight (8) in Block  
 number eleven (11) on Noble Street containing forty feet front & twenty feet  
 deep together with all the privileges thereto in any wise appertaining  
 To have & to hold the afore granted premises to the Right Reverend John H.  
 Bostwick D.D. Bishop of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the Diocese  
 of Georgia & his successors in Office in trust for the use of a parish of the Prot-  
 estant Episcopal Church to be hereafter formed in the town of Valdosta  
 And the said Thomas P. Morris will & his heirs executors & administrators  
 shall the said property to the said Right Reverend John H. Bostwick  
 Bishop of the Protestant Episcopal Church of Georgia & his  
 successors in Office forever warrant & defend against  
 the lawful demands of all persons whatsoever.

Deed from Isaac Williams to Daniel Elder

Jefferson County This indenture made this 28<sup>th</sup> day of October in the year  
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & seventy one, was be-  
tween Isaac Williams of the one part & Daniel Elder of the other part both of the  
County & State aforesaid. Witnesseth that the said Williams for & in consideration  
of the sum of two hundred dollars to him in hand paid at & before the sealing &  
delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath bargain-  
ed & sold & by these presents doth grant bargain sell & convey unto said Elder  
all that tract or parcel of land Situate lying & being in the Eleventh district  
of Irwin County & State aforesaid known & distinguished in the plan of said  
district as lot number three hundred & twenty five (325) and which lot was  
drawn by the said Isaac Williams containing four hundred & eighty acres  
more or less. To have & to have said tract or parcel of land unto him the  
said Elder his heirs & assigns together with all & singular the rights  
members & appurtenances thereto belonging to him & theirs own proper use  
benefit & behoof forever in fee simple. And the said Williams  
the said bargain promises to the said Elder his heirs & assigns  
with covenant & forever defines the right & thereof against the claims of
