Deed: Protestant Episcopal Church. to J.M. Smith.
State of Georgia, Chatham County.

This Indenture, Made this the 29th. day of December, in the year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nine, between Frederick F. Reese, an Bishop of Georgia, and Successor of the Right Reverend John W. Heckwith, D.D. Bishop of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the Diocese of Georgia, of the County of Chatham, and State aforesaid, as party of the first part, and J.M. Smith, of the County of Lowndes, of the State of Georgia, of the second part, Witnesseth: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Four Thousand, Five Hundred & 00/100 Dollars (\$4,500.00), in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part and his successors in office all that tract or parcel of land situated, lying and being in the Town of Valdosta, County of Lowndes and State of Georgia, known and distinguished in the plan of said Town as Lot Number Eight (8), in Block Number Eleven (11), on the East side of Ashley Street, containing Forty (40) feet front and Ninety (90) feet deep.
