"GETTING TO KNOW YOU" - A STUDY OF CHILDREN IN FAR AWAY LANDS

- 1. To give the child a view of the world as his home and to instill in him a lively interest in boys and girls outside his own environment.

- 9. To develop muscular coordination through work and play.
- 10. To enrich the subject with music, literature, films and excursions.
- 11. To establish proper health habits and good manners.
- 12. To develop an appreciation for the wonders of the world that God has created.
- 13. To develop in the child a sense of at-home-ness in and reverence for the Church and of God's need for him in the world.
