Holy Conversations: Lenten Study: 2022

On A Weekday Evening, beginning with a Lenten Supper at 6 PM

Imagine sitting around a table with 7 or 8 fellow Christ Church members for five meals and five conversations. Imagine how much you will learn about Christ Church and about them, how much of God's love and presence will surface.

You will be asked to sign up in advance. Each evening will begin with a light Lenten supper. There will be activities for youth and children.

Session #1: Creating a Timeline, week of March 6th.

We will share how we found out about Christ Church, when we became part of the community, and a story about Christ Church that catches the essence of who we are.

Session # 2, "The Things I Value...", Week of March 13th.

What event or experience at Christ Church has been most important to you? And, in what ways have you contributed to the life of Christ Church? What qualities do these experiences speak to?

Session #3: Telling Our Story: Dealing with hurts and disappointments, Week of March 20th.

How have you been hurt and disappointed at Christ Church, perhaps stories you've never shared? How can you move forward? This evening will conclude with a service of healing and reconciliation in the church.

Session #4: When Our Safe Place Changes: The Bridge to Wishes, Hopes and Dreams, Week of March 27th.

Considering the changes, you are experiencing at Christ Church, what are your hopes and dreams for the future of this community and how do you see yourself investing in that vision?

Session #5: What drives my spiritual life? Week of April 3rd.

In what way(s) do you experience God? And, in what way(s) do others at Christ Church experience God? What can we learn from each other? How do our experiences of God, though different, complement one another and make for a more whole community?
