The following items are particularly noteworthy:

The Rev. Kevin Kelly was recommended unanimously by the Search Committee to serve as the next Christ Church Rector. The Vestry unanimously affirmed the recommendation. Father Kelly's ministry with us will begin no later than January 18, 2026.

Junior Warden, Mike Tanner reported that the Carroll Building (Rectory) needs a new roof. The JH Strickland bid was accepted the job for \$11,216.00.

Many capital improvement projects havebeen completed this year. No additional ones are currently pending. A list of small projects will be generated with the vestry prioritizing them.

The Vestry voted unanimously to paint the front doors of the church red. Bobby Yarbrough completed that project.

The 204th Diocesan Convention will be held November 6 - 8, 2025 in Statesboro, GA, David Sandbach, Molly Stevenson and Bobby Yarbrough will be the delegates, with Ed Mistick and Elise Sandbach serving as Alternates.

Committee membership guidelines will be implemented.

The Stewardship Campaign is underway. Jeani Synyard is coordinating parishioners to speak during each Sunday service to explain why they commit and pledge to Christ Church. This year's theme is Share the Love.

A Georgia Emergency ManagementHomeland Security Agency (GEMA/HS) security grant for the FEMA Nonprofit Security Grant Program (NSP). Grants are available for nonprofits at high risk of security threats, including places of worship. Christ Church is applying for a grant.
